Collections

Over 60,000 printed books, dating back to the 15th century, on subjects including medicine, botany, science and travel.

Over 400 deposited manuscript collections, including the papers of scientists such as Joseph Black (who discovered carbon dioxide).

Medical objects, such as cabinets and instruments, including a medicine chest used by Bonnie Prince Charlie's physician at the Battle of Culloden.
