

PERTH CATHEDRAL

Part of the Scottish Episcopal Church, the first Anglican cathedral in Britain to be built since the Reformation, founded in 1850 to serve as the seat of the Bishop of St. Andrews, Dunkeld and Dunblane.



A Category 'A' Listed Building designed by the noted Victorian architect William Butterfield, with fine architecture and stained glass.

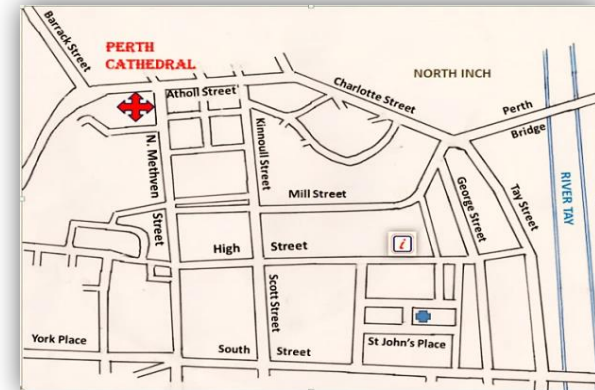


Named after St. Ninian, who introduced Christianity to Scotland in AD 397, a place of tranquillity and prayer near the city centre.
